Dear Parents, Staff and Students:

Integrated Pest Management (IPM) is a widely accepted approach to pest management that results in effective suppression of pest populations while minimizing human health and environmental hazards. The District does have a monthly Pest Management Program. As a rule, all services are conducted on the second Friday of each month after school hours. Areas that are inspected and/or treated include kitchens, food storage, pantry, janitor's closets, teachers' lounge and boiler room, inspection of cafeterias, vending areas and locker rooms.

No unnecessary treatments will be applied. If treatment is merited, the application is applied only to cracks and crevices. In extreme cases, aerosol spray is used to treat an infested area with a six-hour sustaining effect.

The Bug Man Inc., who is hired by the District for our Pest Management needs, has provided in each of the Administrative Offices, a binder containing the service ticket for each appointment. Included in this binder, are all of the Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for any pesticides that might be applied. These records are available for your review anytime during business hours.
