



Meridian ISD Flowchart for COVID-19

To be considered exposed to COVID-19, you would have had **close contact** with a person who is test confirmed to have Covid. Close contact is further defined as (a) being directly exposed to infectious secretions or (b) within 6 feet of a confirmed case during a cumulative period (15 minutes) within 24 hours. Factors such as masks and dividers may affect the determination of **close contact**. Either (a) or (b) defines close contact if it occurred during the infectious period of the case, further defined as 2 days prior to symptom onset/diagnosis to 10 days after symptom onset/diagnosis.
