

Nonprofit organizations may apply to the School Board to distribute and/or allow consumption of alcohol on District property when applying for use of the school facilities. The Board may permit the possession and consumption of alcohol beverages on District property consistent with state law, local ordinances and this policy.

I. Under no circumstances will alcohol beverages be sold or consumed inside the school buildings. Use of the ticket booths or concession booths is permissible.

2. Distribution and consumption of alcohol will not be permitted during any school-sponsored activity.

3. Sale and distribution of alcohol, if permitted, must comply with state law provisions and local ordinances. The location of the sale of the alcohol will be in accordance with specific direction given at the time of the request.

4. Consumption of alcohol beverages, if permitted, must be conducted within the confines of the athletic spectator areas, not in any play field, or within 20 feet of the sales area. Removal of sold alcohol from the spectator areas is not permissible. As with any facility use, all containers must be disposed of properly.
