If you select “I will provide information about my parent(S), you will answer the following questions:

- My parents live together (married or unmarried).
- My parents are divorced or separated and I live with one parent more than the other.
- My parents are divorced or separated, and I live with both parents equally.
- I was legally adopted.

Because the FAFSA form belongs to the student, “you” and “your” always refers to the student.

Click “Proceed to the IRS to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.” Then click on next screen “Proceed to the IRS”

The next screens say that the parent should enter his or her credentials in order to use the Data Retrieval Tool. The parent FSA ID username, email address, or phone number AND the FSA ID Password will be needed to proceed.

If the DRT is not available for the parent or the parent does not want to use the DRT, he or she will have to enter the financial information from their IRS Form 1040.

Once the parent information has been retrieved or input, the student will have to enter their tax filing status. Use the same process as above for the student tax information. It may be retrieved with the DRT or entered by hand.

SIGN AND SUBMIT

Question – Are you a paid preparer? (answer is no)

Review the FAFSA Summary information to see if it is accurate.

Read the Agreement of Terms.

Choose to agree to the terms outlined or log out of FAFSA.

Click the blue “Sign and Submit FAFSA Form.”

Both the student and parent have to sign the form. Each must use their FSA ID information to sign the form.

If done correctly, “Congratulations, (student’s name)!” will appear on the next screen.

Direction say to watch for an email notification saying the FAFSA form was processed.
