**Qty: 4 - \$5,000.00 Scholarships (payable in \$1,250 installments per semester until exhausted).**

**Qty: 26 - \$1,000.00 Scholarships (payable in one lump sum at time of awards).**

The deadline to apply is April 7, 2023 and all applications must be submitted prior to 6:00 pm on the day of the deadline.

\*The \$5,000 scholarship recipients shall receive their \$1,250 payments payable per semester including summer semesters, however summer semesters are not required. Must be enrolled a minimum of 9 hours per year. If recipient withdraws from the minimum number of required hours per year, recipient understands he/she will be surrendering the remaining balance and is entitled to no further payments. Should recipient attend and complete a trade school within three semesters, the remaining balance will be issued upon proof of completion/graduation. Recipients are responsible for submitting proof of enrollment prior to the second week of each semester via [PMedinaScholarship@gmail.com](mailto:PMedinaScholarship@gmail.com) to receive their payment.
