Dear Students, Parents and Guardians,

I am writing to let you know Lyman Memorial High School student has tested positive for COVID-19. The student was last in school on Friday, December 4th. I have consulted with Uncas Health District regarding this case as well as the two I informed you of on Friday. All contact tracing and quarantining protocols have been implemented appropriately.

While LMS was placed into Distance Learning through December 15, because we do not have the substitutes available to cover for the teachers who are considered close contacts. We do not have any teachers who are considered close contacts of the Lyman student. **We will continue with In School instruction for Lyman.**

We have teachers and IAs out for "normal reasons". With COVID-19 adding to the need for additional substitutes, it is becoming more difficult to provide substitute coverage. We will not be able to keep our schools open without appropriate class coverage. During COVID-19, the Connecticut State Department of Education has relaxed the requirements to substitute in school.

Substitute Authorization (No BA/BS)

Minimum Requirements:

- At least 18 years old
- High school diploma or equivalent
- Experience with school-age children
