TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENT & USAGE POLICY STUDENT AND PARENT AGREEMENT FORM

INTERNET ACCESS AND COMPUTER USAGE POLICY

I have read the Hillsboro R-III School District Technology Usage policy, administrative regulations, and netiquette guidelines and agree that my child, ward or child within my care, will abide by their provisions. I understand that violation of these provisions (Sample violations include visiting prohibited and/or inappropriate websites, installing or using software/games not owned by the district, using your network drive to store data or programs that are not used in an approved class project, etc.) may result in disciplinary action taken against my child, ward or child within my care, including but not limited to suspension or revocation of their access to district technology, and suspension or expulsion from school.

I understand that my child's or ward's technology usage is not private and that the school district will monitor my child's or ward's use of district technology, including but not limited to accessing browser logs, e-mail logs, and any other history of use including on student-owned devices connected to district technology. I consent to district interception of or access to all communications sent, received or stored by my child or ward using the district's technology, pursuant to state and federal law, even if the district's technology resources are accessed remotely.

I agree to be responsible for any unauthorized costs arising from my child's, ward's or child within my care's use of the district's technology resources. I agree to be responsible for any damages incurred by my child, ward or child within my care.

Computer Software Applications

Our district utilizes several computer software applications and web-based services, operated not by this school, but by third parties. These include Edmodo, Kahoot, Moby Max and similar educational programs.

In order for our students to use these programs and services, certain personally identifiable information – such as the students' names must be provided to the website operator. These websites must provide parental notification and obtain parental consent before collecting personal information from children under the age of 13. Please note, we will never disclose social security numbers and do not store those records in our database. The law permits schools such as ours to consent to the collection of personal information on behalf of all of its students, thereby eliminating the need for individual parental consent given directly to the website operator. This form, when completed, will constitute consent for our schools to provide personally identifiable information for your child such as first name, last name, and username.
