



2022 Children of Members Scholarship Instructions

Applications and all required attachments must be received by North Western Electric Cooperative, Inc. (NWEC) by 4:00 p.m. on **February 11, 2022**. Scholarship interviews will be held on **March 9, 2022** at Defiance College and all eligible applicants are required to participate on that day in order to be considered for the scholarship award. Additional information will be mailed to the applicants prior to that date regarding specific interview times.

Scholarship Details

PURPOSE:

In order to carry on an educational and training program that encourages Ohio's rural youth to further their education and gives them an opportunity to become more aware of careers in the rural electric program, the following scholarship awards program is offered by NWEC and Ohio's Electric Cooperatives, Inc. (OEC).

SCHOLARSHIPS: DIVISION I – BOYS DIVISION II – GIRLS

The **LOCAL** cash scholarship awards for <u>each</u> division are as follows:

First place	\$1500
Second place	\$750

<u>One</u> local first place winner of this scholarship will advance to the statewide level and **must be** available to interview on April 12, 2022 in Columbus, OH where they will compete for additional cash.

The **STATEWIDE** cash scholarship awards are as follows:

RULES:

To be eligible for the OEC scholarships, the following provisions will govern the acceptance of applicants from the local cooperatives:

 Applicants must be the son, daughter, or <u>legal</u> ward of a permanent <u>residential</u> NWEC member-owner receiving service for the duration of the 2021-2022 academic year (August 2021 - June 2022). Children/wards of NWEC <u>commercial</u> member-owners are not eligible unless one of their parents/legal guardians is also a permanent <u>residential</u> NWEC memberowner.





RULES (cont.):

- 2. Applicants must be graduating seniors who have all basic credits for college or proper vocational or technical school entrance. A "proper vocational or technical school" is defined as a post-secondary institution where credits can be transferred to a state accredited four-year college.
- 3. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of <u>3.5 or above</u> on a 4.0 scale or an equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale.
- 4. Winners must provide proof of enrollment in an accredited college or proper vocational/technical school of students' choice to claim their scholarship. Winners who are accepted and then enrolled in an accredited school of nursing, working toward a degree, are also eligible.
- 5. Students may not be immediate family members of, or reside with, people who are employed by **any** electric cooperative in Ohio (employees, trustees, managers, OEC, **or** affiliated organizations such as Buckeye Power, Inc., RESCO, etc.).
- 6. Applications must be submitted (typed to be accepted) on the forms provided by NWEC or downloaded from <u>www.nwec.com/scholarship-programs</u>. **Applications must be returned to NWEC by 4 p.m. on Friday, February 11, 2022.**
- Application information must be confined to the official application form. The only attachments permitted are grade transcripts, teacher recommendations and one photo of the applicant. Teacher recommendations must be no longer than <u>500 words</u>.
- 8. Applicants who receive "full-ride" scholarships (i.e., scholarships that cover the cost of tuition, room, board *and* books) to the schools of their choice are **not eligible** for scholarships from NWEC or OEC.
- 9. All scholarships must be accepted in the first academic year following the student's high school graduation. However, an extension of one year may be granted for just cause in the judgment of the President/CEO of NWEC or of OEC. In the event students are unable to fulfill their enrollment obligation under this program, the awards are forfeited.
- 10. Personal interviews will be conducted with eligible applicants. Applicants are not permitted to bring any outside materials to their interviews (e.g., electronic presentations, props, handouts, etc.).
- 11. Winners will be notified as soon as possible after judging. One winner will be chosen to represent NWEC in the statewide competition where he or she will compete for an additional scholarship award.
- 12. These rules (dated hereon) supersede all previous rules for this scholarship.

JUDGING:

The judges, following personal interviews with each eligible applicant, will score up to a maximum of 40 points for scholastic record, 30 points for personal achievement, school and community activities, 15 points for personal interview with the judges relating to poise, personality and appearance and 15 points for cooperative knowledge, based upon an online training course which can be found at www.ohioec.org/orientation. A transcript of the course can be downloaded for study purposes once you have completed the course online.
