Applications and all required attachments must be received by North Western Electric Cooperative, Inc. (NWEC) by **4:00 p.m. on February 11, 2022**. Scholarship interviews will be held on **March 9, 2022** at Defiance College and all eligible applicants are required to participate on that day in order to be considered for the scholarship award. Additional information will be mailed to the applicants prior to that date regarding specific interview times.

Scholarship Details

PURPOSE:

The **Touchstone Energy® Achievement Scholarship** has been created to reward those students who have committed themselves to the pursuance of a college education despite unique and substantial personal challenges which may have befallen them. This special scholarship rewards students expressing the same values in their lives as the Touchstone Energy® brand:

- **Accountability** the applicant demonstrates a high level of maturity through accountability for their actions;
- **Integrity** the applicant expresses highest standards of character;
- **Innovation** the applicant demonstrates innovation and determination in coping with their circumstances;
- **Commitment to Community** the applicant has good citizenship traits and a record of contribution to their local community.

SCHOLARSHIPS: One winner will receive a \$1,000 cash award. The award is non-renewable.

RULES:

- Applicants must be the son, daughter, or <u>legal</u> ward of a permanent <u>residential</u> NWEC member-owner receiving service for the duration of the 2021-2022 academic year (August 2021 June 2022). Children/wards of NWEC's <u>commercial</u> member-owners are not eligible unless one of their parents/legal guardians is also a permanent residential NWEC member-owner.
- Applicants must be graduating seniors who have all basic credits for college or proper vocational or technical school entrance. A "proper vocational or technical school" is defined as a post-secondary institution where credits can be transferred to a state-accredited fouryear college.
- 3. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of <u>2.75 or above</u> on a 4.0 scale, or an equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale.
- 4. Winners must provide proof of enrollment in an accredited college or proper vocational/technical school of the student's choice to claim their scholarship. Winners,

who are accepted and then enrolled in an accredited school of nursing, working toward a degree, are also eligible.

- 5. <u>Character:</u> A Letter of Recommendation is required from an independent sponsor (e.g., school representative, church or community leader, etc.) that explains how the applicant's character has played roles in enabling him/her to succeed. Character traits such as integrity, innovation and accountability should be mentioned. Specific examples of situations that show these character traits and other strong traits are encouraged.
- 6. <u>Special Achievements:</u> A Letter of Nomination is required from a second independent sponsor outlining the applicant's relevant life experiences and traits that clearly demonstrate determination in the face of adversity and/or commitment to community. Consideration will be given to applicants who have overcome substantial personal or family hardships and have demonstrated achievement through personal initiative and good citizenship.
- 7. Members of the immediate families and persons residing in the households of trustees, managers, or employees of NWEC are not eligible to participate in the competition.
- 8. Applications must be submitted on forms provided by NWEC or downloaded from www.nwec.com/scholarship-programs and must be submitted to the NWEC office by 4 p.m. on February 11, 2022.
- 9. Application information must be confined to the official application form. The only attachments permitted are grade transcripts, one Letter of Recommendation and one Letter of Nomination, the guidelines for which are attached.
- Applicants who receive "full-ride" scholarships (i.e., scholarships that cover the cost of tuition, room, board and books) to the schools of their choice are not eligible for scholarships from NWEC.
- 11. All scholarships must be accepted in the first academic year following the student's high school graduation. However, an extension of one year may be granted for just cause, in the judgment of the President/CEO of NWEC. In the event students are unable to fulfill their enrollment obligation under this program, the awards are forfeited.
- 12. Personal interviews will be conducted with eligible applicants. Applicants are not permitted to bring any outside materials to their interviews (e.g., electronic presentations, props, handouts, etc.).
- 13. All rules stated within this document conform to the policies and program guidelines as set forth by NWEC.
- 14. These rules (dated heron) supersede all previous rules for this scholarship.

JUDGING:

The judges, following personal interviews with each eligible applicant, will score up to a maximum of 50 points for special achievement, 20 points for scholastic achievement, 20 points for character, and 10 points for cooperative knowledge, based on an online training course which can be found at www.ohioec.org/orientation. A transcript of the course can be downloaded for study purposes once you have completed the course online.

- Other pertinent comments from the letter writer.
- Overview: Why do you think the applicant should be awarded the scholarship?
