The Hancock Central High School Class of 1982 announces the 2018 **Hancock Central Scholarship Awards Program.** Under the Program, selected college bound graduating seniors will each be awarded a minimum \$500.00 scholarship. The donations collected during the fundraiser will determine the amount and number of scholarships.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community college or four (4)-year college or university.
- * Applicants must have a 3.0 G.P.A.
- * Applicants must demonstrate participation in community volunteerism and extracurricular activities.
- * Scholarship funds will be paid during the month of **August 2018—directly to the college**, not the student. The scholarship funds will be issued to the college or university upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester, which includes the Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- * Applications must be received by the Scholarship committee no later than <u>April 27, 2018</u>. Late applications will not be accepted.
