- Attend Senior Meeting (Parents are encouraged to attend)
- Apply for PIN through FAFSA (student and parent)

October

- Continue working on the Common Application or schools application
- Know college application deadlines
- Early Acceptance Deadlines begin
- Polish/Fine tune college Essay
- -File with FAFSA (opens October 1st)

November

- Prepare to submit college applications (know deadlines!)
- Check scholarship list on Naviance

Capstone...

- Attend Senior Capstone project assembly in September
- Return topic proposal to your advisor by the end of September
- Beginning of December $1^{\rm st}$ check in
- End of January -2^{nd} check in
- End of March 3rd check in
- April & May Capstone Presentations

December

- Submit college applications by deadlines
- Check scholarship list on Naviance
- Submit SAT/ACT scores to all colleges (as applicable)

January

- Continue looking at scholarships
- Request semester grades sent to colleges (if needed)

February

- Continue looking at scholarships
- -Work on Local Scholarships
- Sign up for AP Exams (if applicable)

March

- Continue looking at scholarhsips

April

- Inform college/university you plan on attending
- Let your counselor know your postsecondary plans
