Circle USD 375 Event Spectator Guidelines for Winter Sports Season

We are excited to announce that we are going to move forward with allowing **two (2) parents/guardians per participant(s) family into our Winter sports activities.** It is very important that we all work together and adhere to these procedures in order to maintain the safety of our students, staff and community. In conjunction with KSHSAA and our local health experts we have developed the following procedures.

- KSHSAA activities will allow for attendance of up to two parents/guardians per participant(s) family as allowed by local board of education or health department restrictions. Please note only legal parents or guardians will be accepted into the games.
 - Participants include players, coaches, student managers, cheer squads, dance teams, pep bands, and student journalists. Some of these groups may not be in attendance at every event so it is important to check with your child and coach to see if your child is a participant in that activity.
 - A pass gate will have each participant with their two parents or guardians listed.
 - Admission will be \$6 per parent/guardian at CHS events and \$4 per parent/guardian at CMS events.
 - Identification may be required for entry. Please bring your ID to verify your name on the pass gate list.
 - Spectator limitations apply to both home and away events.
 - Siblings or children/infants are not allowed to attend.
 - A face covering is required for all in attendance and at all times.
 - The face covering should be worn in the manner it is intended to be worn- covering the mouth and nose.
 - The only exception is provided for athletes during the time they are competing and for officials during active play.
 - Failure to wear the face covering in the manner suggested may result in the parent/guardian being asked to leave. We certainly do not want to do this so please assist us by adhering to the mask requirements.
 - Concessions will not be available and no outside food or drinks will be allowed in the gyms except for athletes.
 - Social distancing is to be practiced at all times. Locations will be marked on the bleachers to allow for social distancing.
 - Parents/guardians will not be allowed on the court/mat or by locker rooms.
 - Parents/guardians attending basketball games should arrive just prior to the start of their child's game.
 - **Once your child is finished participating in their respective game or meet we ask that the parent/guardians exit the facility in order for us to maintain the appropriate crowd size as suggested by our local health experts.**
- Certain events may be more restrictive to parent/guardian attendance such as tournaments and invitationals.
- Live Streaming will be available for all home events.

Health and Safety Guidelines

- Health Screening: All spectators will be screened upon entry to the event.
- Temperature checks will be taken upon arrival. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to attend.
- Face coverings are required for all in attendance and at all times. The face covering must be worn in the manner it is intended to be worn covering the mouth and nose.
