As you know, our area is experiencing an increasing number of COVID-19 cases. This condition not only poses health and safety concerns for the school community, but staffing concerns as well. Due to the impact of COVID-19 this school year on our school community, staffing levels are razor thin right now. With the holidays quickly approaching and colder weather arriving, the combination of larger gatherings as well as more time indoors provides an opportunity for this virus to spread and further impact our schools.

As a proactive approach to limiting student and staff exposure to COVID-19 due to holiday gatherings and festivities, Eatontown Public Schools will follow a remote educational schedule during the weeks of December 21, 2020 and January 4, 2021.
