Field Advertising

This topic was brought up after the Activities State of the Schools presentation at a previous School Board meeting. It was mentioned that the PR Committee should be involved so that the Committee is aware of advertising that is brought into the schools. Bryan Carpenter will reach out to the Policy Committee about reviewing advertising policies that either are or should be in place for the District.

2. <u>Technology</u>

- October 7 Workshop Day Kevin shared the work of the workshop day on unit development and the role of technology to support teachers in the creation of the units
- SIS/LMS Review Committee Kevin shared the progress of the Committee. A team of school staff members has met to create a metric to measure different systems that are available. The next step is to hold community parent forums to get the view of parents as to what they would like to see in a learning management system. These meetings are scheduled between Oct. 24 and Nov. 16.
- Sub Calling/AESOP This year the District is using a new sub system titled AESOP. AESOP is an automated program that will allow teachers to sign up online or by phone and have the system contact subs to schedule the sub. Teachers are being trained now and subs will be trained in the near future. The system will be put into place fully after everyone has been trained.
- Digital Divide. NY Times and Portland Press Herald David Allen heard a podcast that describe efforts in a southern US community that had 25% of homes in the community that were without Internet access. He remembered a <u>survey</u> that RSU 57 did last year that showed 89% or our students in grades 7-12 reporting that they have Internet access at home. He felt that the district should begin discussions on how we can increase this number.

There are devices available that allow districts to sign out to students to take home so that they can access the Internet at home to complete work. These devices are also available for use on buses.

The Committee would like to keep this issue on our radar screen so that we can be aware of opportunities that become available in the future.
