Remote Learning Attendance

Attendance is taken for remote learning, just like it is for in-person learning. Students that are learning remotely are required to sign into the live lessons that teachers send to them and are also required to do the assignments in Seesaw or Google Classroom. Teachers are sending their remote attendance to the office, daily, based on remote students being active in their remote assignments. Just like in-person learning, a student is considered truant if they miss 7 consecutive days or have a total of 10 days absent. The school will attempt to contact parents when a student is approaching the numbers to rectify the solution, but if we are unable to make contact and move towards fixing the problem, the school is required to contact the authorities. If the internet is an issue with remote learning, please contact the school for a hotspot or other solutions. It is our goal to help students attend school regularly, whether it is remotely or in-person.
