Snook ISD is excited to inform you about this year's 1-to-1 device program available for our students beginning next semester! It marks a new beginning in which students will not only have access to digital instructional materials, but they will have access to educational resources outside the classroom, all at the click of a button. This initiative is intended to develop 21st-century skills for all students, as well as engage our students in collaboration, communication, critical thinking and creativity.

Snook ISD will be issuing a device and charger to each of our students as they become available. Whether students are on or off campus, these devices are to be used for educational purposes ONLY. Teachers will vary their device use requirements throughout the school year, but students are to use this tool for various projects, research, instruction, and assignments.

For your student to receive their device, the student and parent must thoroughly read, sign and return both of the Technology Handbook and Acceptable Use Policy forms, which will be sent home with students, to Snook ISD on or before **December 18**. Secondary students will also be required to attend a training presentation discussing device care and internet safety. The presentation along with the Technology Handbook and Acceptable Use Policy are linked below. It is essential that parents/guardians and students understand and abide by the policies and procedures set forth in the 1-to-1 device program Snook ISD is offering.
