THIS WEEK:

Phonics:

This week we will produce rhyming words, we will write and recognize words with /k/ sound, spelled ck. We will also add phonemes to a word. We will decode and write words with sound /s/ and sound /z/, spelled ss.

Spelling:

Spelling - black, sick, tack, stuck, stack, sack, back, luck, walk, what
High-Frequency - jump, she, take, walk, what
Vocabulary - buds, soil, stems, leaves

Reading:

Our story this week is *The Lifecycle of a Sunflower*. We will be able to tell what happened first, next and last. We will also be able to recognize synonyms.

Math:

Your students will be able to do addition facts adding 1. They will also be able to sort items and create a graph. They will be able to weigh objects using non-standard units.
