THIS WEEK:

Phonics:

This week we will decode and write words with final consonant blends, decode words with initial consonant blends, and segment and blend phonemes. We will also decode words with inflectional ending -s.

Spelling:

Spelling - and, ask, felt, held, mask, pond, ramp, went, use, from High-Frequency - blue, from, think, this, use Vocabulary - polar bear, kangaroo, penguin

Reading:

Our story this week is How Do Baby Animals Grow? We will continue to build our knowledge of informational texts, and using context clues. We will learn about interrogative sentences. We will explore the features and simple graphics of informational text.

Math:

Your students will be able to find a sum by counting on. They will make and read a graph. Your student will also be able to add zero to addition facts.
