LEARNING OBJECTIVES/GOALS

ELA/Reading: Scholars can learn more about realistic fiction by **analyzing plot elements** (Shared Reading for the week is "A Pet for Calvin" from *Dude: Stories and Stuff for Boys* by Barbara Robinson). Scholars will construct a plausible narrative that adheres to the plot structure expected in realistic fiction.

No New Spelling for the Week of 01/23 to 01/27.

Writing: Scholars can recognize (and correct) sentence fragments. Scholars will master compound sentences and identify the parts of a complex sentence. Scholars will learn the hard and fast rules of quotations.
