LEARNING OBJECTIVES/GOALS

ELA/Reading: I can learn more about **theme reflections** by reading a text that helps me explain literary structure in a drama and legend (Shared Reading for the week is *The Carp* by Marie Yuen and *The Hermit Thrush* by Dana Crum).
