

## LEARNING OBJECTIVES/GOALS

**ELA/Reading**: I can learn more about **theme reflections** by reading poetry (Shared Reading for the week is *The Carp* by Marie Yuen and *The Hermit Thrush* by Dana Crum and shared reading "Artist to Artist" by Davida Adejouma and "Sepia" and "Spruce" from *Tan to Tamarind* by Malathi Michelle Iyengar).

Words of the Week (\*Spelling words are typically test every week; Continuation of last week due to weather\*):

- Vocabulary for the Week: quell, tactics, persevere, conscientious, supportive
