EDGEWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION RESOLUTION FOR THE SUPPORT OF MILITARY CHILDREN AND FAMILIES

WHEREAS, THE EDGEWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT HAS A LONG HISTORY OF SUPPORTING OUR MILITARY VETERANS AND THOSE CURRENTLY SERVING; AND, WHEREAS, OUR COUNTRY AND COMMUNITY OWE THE DAILY FREEDOMS TO THE MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES, OUR VETERANS, THEIR FAMILY MEMBERS, AND THE LOVED ONES WHO SHARE IN THEIR SERVICE; AND,

WHEREAS, THE EDGEWOOD BOARD OF EDUCATION ACKNOWLEDGES THAT MILITARY FAMILIES FACE UNIQUE CHALLENGES DUE TO DEPLOYMENT, REINTEGRATION, SERVICE IN COMBAT ZONES AND RELOCATIONS; AND,

WHEREAS, THE EDGEWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT WHOLEHEARTEDLY RECOGNIZES AND APPRECIATES THE SACRIFICES OF ALL THOSE WHO HAVE SERVED OUR COUNTRY AND THOSE CURRENTLY SERVING; AND,

WHEREAS, WE CELEBRATE THE EXCEPTIONAL SERVICE, STRENGTH, RESILIENCE, AND CHARACTER OF ALL MILITARY-CONNECTED STUDENTS, FAMILIES, AND VETERANS IN THE EDGEWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT COMMUNITY; AND,

WHEREAS, THE EDGEWOOD BOARD OF EDUCATION WISHES TO RECOGNIZE THE IMPORTANCE OF SUPPORTING THE EDGEWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT'S GRADUATES WHO ARE NOW SERVING IN THE MILITARY AND THEIR FAMILIES IN OUR COMMUNITY; AND,

WHEREAS, THE EDGEWOOD BOARD OF EDUCATION WISHES TO FURTHER IMPROVE THE SUPPORT, UNDERSTANDING, AND OUTREACH FOR THE MILITARY FAMILIES ATTENDING OUR SCHOOLS; AND,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE EDGEWOOD BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE EDGEWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT AFFIRMS A COMMITMENT TO SUPPORT OUR MILITARY-CONNECTED STUDENTS AND THEIR FAMILIES AND IS DEDICATED TO PROVIDING RESOURCES AND PROGRAMS, WHICH COULD BENEFIT STUDENTS AND FAMILIES ACADEMICALLY, SOCIALLY, AND EMOTIONALLY; AND,
