Semester Mid-Terms

This Monday, Dec. 14, marks mid-terms, the midway point of the semester. Students are encouraged to have all of their work for the first half of the semester turned in and parents are asked to check on how their children are doing and what needs done for the rest of the term.

Mid-term grades for students in grades 3-12 can be viewed online by using your parent login and access code at www.schoology.com. If you do not have a Parent Login, contact your school to receive one.

Final grades also will be available through Schoology, though parents can log in to check current grades at any time. The grading period for K-12 ends Jan. 22.

Mid-term grades for students in grades K-2 will be emailed. Each student has a Microsoft 365 email account, and those account logins were distributed in August along with iPads.

What Color Are We Now?

WVDE Saturday Education Map: If Wood County is marked **Orange** or **Red** on the Saturday map, in-person classes will be suspended and all students will learn remotely the following week. This map is updated every Saturday evening.

WVDHHR Daily COVID Map: If Wood County is marked **Red** on the WVDHHR daily map, all in-person classes will be suspended and all students will learn remotely until the county reaches a **Green**, **Yellow** or **Gold** designation on the Saturday map. Click the link and scroll down to the WV COVID-19 overview. At the top of the box click "County Alert System." Map is updated at 10 a.m. daily.
