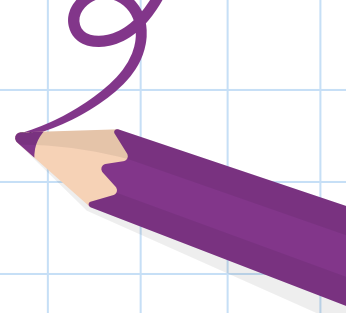

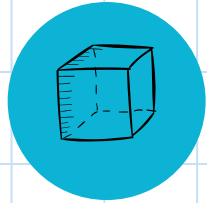
Goal 1: Instructional teams meet regularly to review implementation of effective practice and student progress. (A2.01)

Actions:

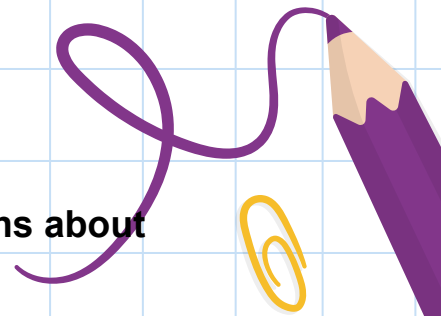
- 1. Hire a qualified, experienced MTSS/Curriculum coach to share and model effective instructional practices and use of instructional resources**
- 2. Grade level teams participate in county-wide collaboration sessions to plan rigorous lessons**
- 3. Grade level teams meet weekly with MTSS/Curriculum coach to collaborate (instructional strategies, data review, NCSCS objectives, lesson planning)**

Actions:

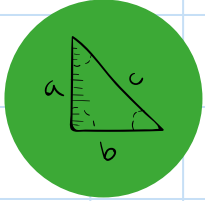
- 1. Create a comprehensive Title I Professional Development Plan**

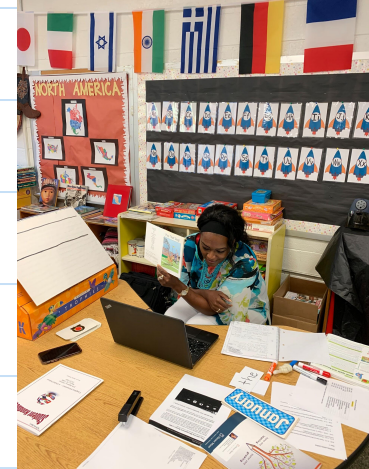
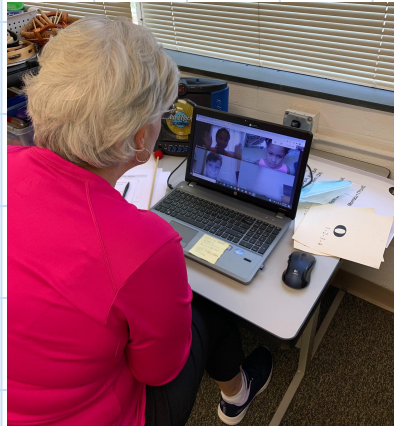
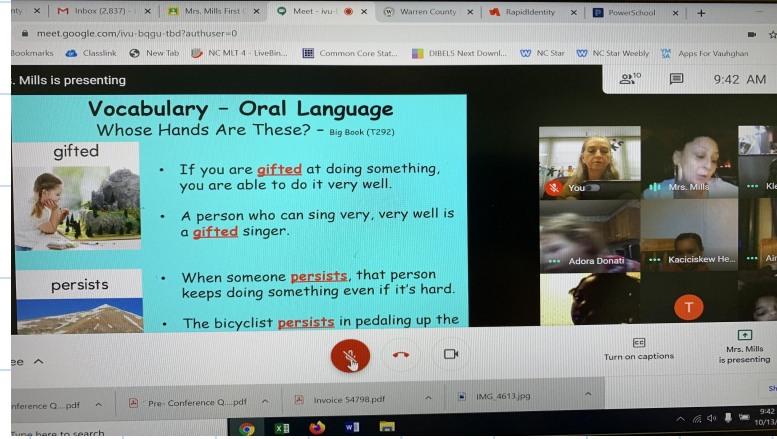
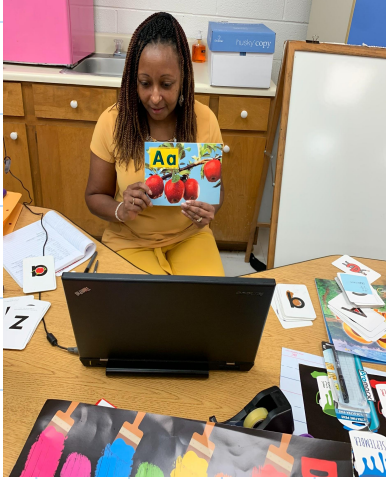
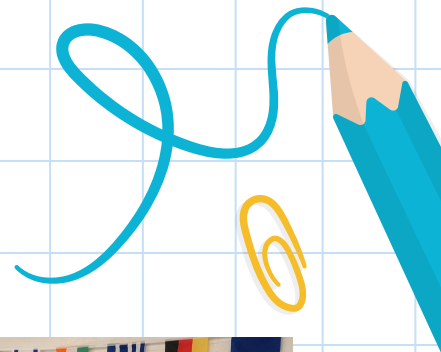
- 1. Attend Google Classroom training and receive CEU's**

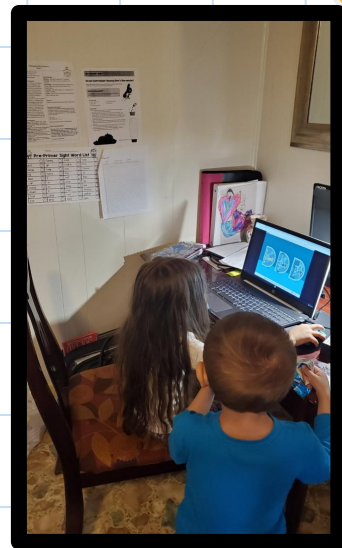
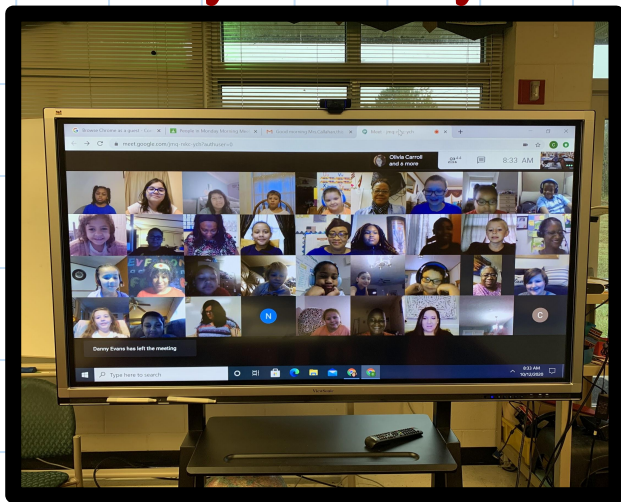
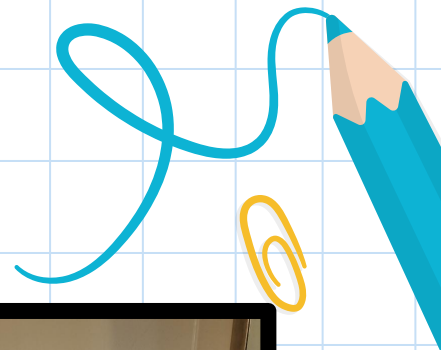
Priority Strategies for 2020-2021
