Job Opening: Career Education Teacher Health Occupations



Job Summary:

Under direction of the department manager, provide extensive expertise to teach Health Occupations I-II / Nurse Assistant courses as part of the Career Education Program; design and implement an effective and appropriate educational and vocational training program for assigned students to prepare them for employment; work collaboratively with pupils, parents, support staff, administrators, health organizations, agencies and community groups to enhance the training and employment opportunities for students; and do other related work as required.

Experience:

Health care industry experience to include long-term care, home health, venipuncture, hospital health care occupations and procedures, doctors' offices, health clinics, State Competencies for Certified Nursing Programs, and health and safety requirements; methodologies, techniques and practices used to educate and train youth and adults in a Health Occupations/Nurse Assistant program; appropriate instructional materials for use in a Health Occupations/Nurse Assistant

program and reliable sources and suppliers; applicable directives, standards, procedures, policies, rules, regulations, codes, laws and guidelines; accepted and effective techniques and strategies for working collaboratively with others in the educational, vocational and job training fields.

Skills and Ability to:

Establish and maintain cooperative and effective working relationships with children and adults contacted in the course of work;

Understand, carry out and communicate oral and written directions;

Write lesson plans for individual and group instructions;

Use diverse teaching strategies to meet students' learning styles, abilities, interests and cultural backgrounds;

Apply classroom management techniques to maintain proper discipline and ensure students remain on task;

Counsel, supervise and evaluate students in didactic and clinical settings;

Establish and maintain good working relationships with educators, administrators and support staff, staff from health care providers, agencies, businesses, and community based organizations;

Maintain accurate records and files, and prepare documents and reports;

Be flexible and receptive to change;

Attend in-service training, conferences and meetings, as needed.
