SCHOOL BOARD VACANCIES

The City of Englewood Board of Education has two open seats and is seeking candidates to fill the vacancies through December 2022. The Board will be holding interviews during the Thursday, May 19, 2022 meeting (6:00 p.m.).

To become a member of a local board of education in New Jersey, you must:

- Be able to read and write,
and
- Hold U.S. citizenship and one (1) year's residency in the school district,
and
- Be registered to vote in the district before filing the letter of interest,
and
- Have no interest in any contract with, or claim against the board,
and
- Not hold office as mayor or member of the municipal governing body,
and
- Not simultaneously hold two elective offices,
and
- Not be disqualified from membership for the conviction of certain crimes. (Within 30 days of election or appointment to the board, a member must undergo a criminal history background investigation through the state Department of Education)

After the interview process, the Board is expected to appoint candidates to the vacated seats at the Thursday, May 19, 2022 meeting (6:00 p.m.).
