23-B-06	APPROVAL – ENGLEWOOD TEACHERS’ ASSOCIATION (ETA) SIDEBAR	
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WHEREAS, the Englewood Board of Education (“Board”) and Englewood Teachers’ Association (“Association”) have previously entered into a Collective Negotiations Agreement covering the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024 (“CNA”);

WHEREAS, the Board and the Association hereby enter into this Sidebar Agreement September 22, 2022, and agree as follows:

- 1) Staff meetings shall be conducted once per month. During the week in which the staff meeting is held, there shall be one (1) tutorial session for 40 minutes.
- 2) During all other weeks, there shall be one (1) tutorial session per week for 40 minutes and the second tutorial session shall be converted to one (1) Professional Learning Community (PLC) session.
- 3) A PLC shall be defined as “A group of teachers that meets regularly, shares expertise, and works collaboratively to improve teaching skills and the academic performance of students.”
- 4) PLC’s are teacher-led and intended to provide a space for members of the school community to come together to share expertise and to improve understanding and knowledge concerning a topic as they work collaboratively to improve the school, teaching, and student learning opportunities.
- 5) In total, there shall be four (4) tutorial sessions per month, and three (3) PLC sessions per month.
- 6) Teachers’ tuition reimbursement shall be calculated utilizing the Rutgers In-State graduate tuition rate for that year.

THEREFORE, IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties, intending to be legally bound, have caused this Sidebar Agreement to be approved and executed.
