Mannheim District 83 Identification of Students for Accelerated Learning Opportunities

Mannheim District 83 ensures that all students are given an opportunity to be screened for placement into accelerated learning. Identification and placement will be determined using the following criteria.

- 1. Identification of Students for Accelerated Placement
 - a. MAP Testing Students in Gr. 3-8
 - i. Fall testing of students in Gr. 3-8
 - ii. Students whose achievement in ELA or Math is in the 90th percentile will advance to the second stage of identification
 - b. CogAT Testing
 - i. Students will take the CogAT Form 7 Screening Form
 - ii. Students whose achievement is in the 90th percentile in the areas of Quantitative, Verbal, and Non-Verbal batteries or a score of 120 or above in any two subtests, will qualify for accelerated learning opportunities
- 2. Determining Eligibility for Accelerated Placement
 - a. The Principal or the referred student's school shall obtain written permission from the student's parent(s) or guardian(s) to evaluate the students for possible accelerated placement after MAP testing
 - b. Upon determining eligibility of accelerated placement, Mannheim District 83 will work with the student's parents or guardians and provide a plan detailing the type of acceleration the child will receive and strategies to support the child.
- 3. Continued Eligibility
 - a. Once identified/qualified for Accelerated Placement, students in Gr. 3-5 will remain qualified. The same will hold true for students in Gr. 6-8.
