## CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

## INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PROGRAM (BEGINNING)

Instrumental music education is an out growth of valuable musical experiences offered to students and provides for the evaluation of musical aptitude and achievement potential of each student prior to entering the instrumental program.

It is accepted that parents generally need assistance in selecting musical instruments and, in most instances, seek advice from music teachers regarding the quality and stability of the instruments.

Therefore, it is the desire of the Ohio County Board of Education to allow all music companies in Ohio County an equal opportunity to provide band instruments to beginning instrumental music students in Ohio County Schools.

It is the policy of the Ohio County Board Education, however, that the recruitment process for beginning instrumental music students will be handled entirely by the music staff of Ohio County Schools in order to guide parents and students in instrumental music education.
