CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

EDUCATIONAL IMPACT: COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT TO COMPLEMENT EDUCATION

The Ohio County Board of Education strongly supports involvement of the community with schools. The administration is charged with ensuring that the community involvement activities are developmentally appropriate to the age and grade of participants, have specific educational benefits to participants, and are not designed to advertise or promote the sole interests of commercial or other non-school agencies and organizations.

The programs of community involvement are to be structured to meet an identified education need, not a commercial motive, and are to be evaluated for educational effectiveness by the county or administration on a continuous basis.

The educational impact of student participation in activities must be outlined by each sponsoring organization in order to provide information to the administration for decision making regarding possible participation.
