DRUG FREE WORKPLACE

The educational community plays an important role in student development of positive lifestyles and proper values. In addition to directly teaching students the hazards of abusing controlled substances, the educational community must also set an example of proper behavior. In order to set that example, and to comply with the Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1988 (Public Law 1090-690, Title V, Subtitle D, and State Board of Education Policy/Regulation 1461), all Ohio County employees are prohibited to unlawfully manufacture, distribute, dispense, possess, or use a controlled substance or alcohol at the workplace, or to report for work under the influence of a controlled substance or alcohol.
