FUNDRAISING

The Ohio County Board of Education is committed to securing and allocating available resources to achieve educational goals in a responsible manner that is both efficient and effective. Accordingly, the Board recognizes that many special activities important to schools are conducted with financial assistance from school parents and patrons and that such activities encourage many parents and community members to actively demonstrate support for the individual school and its programs.

The Board's policy regarding fundraising is not to prohibit but to regulate such activity in order to protect the health and safety of students and prevent encroachment on the instructional day. Donations of substantial gifts or endowments may be recognized by the Board by naming a facility in honor of the donor according to the regulations established.
