


5. Select the topic of interest by clicking on the specific area of interest.





7. It will then open up the videos that can be viewed under each topic. The name of the title, duration and a brief description is provided.





8. When you click on the video, it will open and provide additional information about the video. The lower left-hand corner has additional documents (quiz, leaders guide and/or attendance log) related to the video.




9. Click on the "Play Video" Button to view the video. A new window will open, the video will load and then play.






### **Quiz Utilization**

When viewing videos in TNN, about ½ way through the video, a button will appear for the user to "take the quiz".



Once the quiz is finished, the user will be asked to click on the "submit" button.

Once submitted, a screen will display asking for the email address to be entered where the completed quiz and results will be sent.





The results can either be sent to the user (employee; if they have their own email address) who can then forward it to someone in the company tracking an employee's completion of videos; or they can enter the email address of the person in the company (i.e. Safety Manager; HR Director; Staff Development Coordinator; etc.) who is assigned to track the training.


If a the TNN video is used in a group setting and wants to have employees individually complete the quiz, a paper copy of the quiz is available for downloading and printing. encova.com
