Biondini '66 Recognized for Service

It has been 15 years since Mike Biondini '66 returned to his alma mater as a counselor after retiring from Widefield School District. His continued service to the families of St. Mary's High School was honored this year when he was presented with the school's Marian Award.

Each year members of the St. Mary's family nominate individuals deserving of the Marian Award. The award, which has been given annually since 2001, is presented by the St. Mary's High School Board of Directors in recognition of unselfish service to others and outstanding contributions to the community.

Biondini said he is humbled by the recognition. "I'm in awe of this really," he said. "It's very special to be recognized for doing something that you really love. St. Mary's is a special place."

Admittedly when Biondini returned St. Mary's in June 2002, he never dreamed that a decade and a half later he would still be at the school. But as the years passed, the new opportunities that arose came from within. During his time at St. Mary's, he has been a counselor, assistant principal, golf coach for both the boys and girls teams, principal, and director of Counseling Services.

"For me it's always been about the kids," Biondini said. "As a student at St. Mary's, I had a great experience that prepared me well for the future. Now I've worn a lot of different

hats for St. Mary's. The school is providing a needed service to the community and filling a necessary niche."

Biondini said he has never had a morning that he dreaded having to go to the St. Mary's campus. His service to the school has always been a labor of love.

"I dearly love doing what I do," Biondini said. "I have been fortunate to

be able step in and do what needs to be done. Things grow and prosper when people do what needs to be done and do it with a positive attitude. For me, serving St. Mary's has never been a job; it's been a blessing."

Part of that blessing for Biondini has been seeing his own faith grow during the last 15 years.

"For me faith is the way you treat people, how you interact with others and how you give," he said. "My faith is how I conduct my life on a daily basis. I try in every way to live my faith and let the kids watch."

St. Mary's Students Spend Semester Giving Back

Inspired by their faith, students at St. Mary's High School continuously find ways to give to those in need.

This fall the St. Mary's student body has raised more than \$4,000 for those in need through various campaigns. With hurricanes ravaging the Gulf Coast in the late summer, the St. Mary's family joined together to contribute more than \$2,300 through the efforts of Student Senate, Youth Philanthropy Club (YPC), and Campus Ministry. The funds were given to the National Catholic Education Association's Student to Student campaign to assist Catholic school families affected by the hurricanes.

Earlier in the semester, Students

for Life hosted a bake sale and donated the proceeds to the Life Network. Each October YPC hosts its Penny Wars competition between the classes. This year's Penny Wars brought in more than \$2,100 with the freshman class contributing the most to win the class competition. In early December, YPC presented a check to Catholic Charities.

St. Mary's students give in other ways too. The National Art Honor Society again hosted its Giving Tree this holiday season with gifts being purchased for residents at the Sunny Vista Living Center. Then Senate's annual food drive competition against Manitou garnered more than 5,300 pounds of food for local food banks. This is the fifth year for

the food drive competition, and the fifth win for St. Mary's with a total of 3,320 pounds of food collected from our Pirate family.

"The big winners, of course, are the westside food banks and people," said Rick Champion, St. Mary's theology department chair and faculty adviser for Senate. "I'm really proud of my Senate kids for their work this year and for the students' efforts--and for Manitou, as well. They quadrupled their total from last year, so good effort and good competition."

As they continue to be obedient to God's calling, the St. Mary's family will undoubtedly find more opportunities to give back to their community in the spring semester.

We Believe ...

Our Faith, Our Family, Our Future

Almost three years ago, St. Mary's High School embarked on its We Believe capital campaign. The premise behind the campaign was that operational finances are a challenge for St. Mary's every year as the school struggles to keep tuition affordable while meeting its financial obligations. School leaders decided it was time to address the financial reality of past building projects, and the We Believe campaign was born.

RELIEVING PAST DEBT

Since moving to the Yampa Street campus in 1992, St. Mary's has borrowed \$6 million to purchase the main building, add successive improvements, and open The Grace Center for Community Service and Athletics.

The first priority of the We Believe campaign was to alleviate the existing debt. School leaders pledged at the beginning of the campaign that no building renovations or construction would begin until \$2.5 million of debt service was reached. That focus was part of what drew Don Cloud's attention to the campaign.

"We wanted to give to the We Believe campaign since a primary goal of the campaign is help defer the bond payments for the school," Don said. "It would be great for St. Mary's to get to a point where the school could be released from the bond."

School leaders noted that in order for St. Mary's to function at its full capability, the school must be able to service its current debt without impacting operational funding. Reducing—and ultimately eliminating—St. Mary's current bond obligations would increase operational resources allowing students to directly benefit. Freeing up funds now going to debt retirement would help St. Mary's attract and retain the very best faculty, allow for updated textbooks, expand bus service and extracurricular opportunities, and ensure a successful future for St. Mary's students.

SECONDARY CAMPAIGN PRIORITIES

Once the debt service objectives were met, St. Mary's leaders hoped that funds would be available to create a tuition assistance endowment fund, make enhancements to the current campus, and upgrade The Grace Center.

More than 30 percent of St. Mary's families receive tuition assistance but even that doesn't meet requests. With an increased emphasis on STEM curriculum, school leaders would like to upgrade the science labs and other classrooms. And upgrades to The Grace Center would include adding locker rooms.

The campaign priorities were based on \$10 million of need.

UPDATE ON CAMPAIGN PROGRESS

While giving to the We Believe campaign has fallen short of the \$10 million needed to complete the campaign's priorities, St. Mary's has used the funds collected to move forward with its goals. Greg Garcia, long-time supporter of St. Mary's, said that he and his wife felt it was important to complete their giving goal to the campaign, even if the campaign overall fell short of its intended goal.

"When it came time to commit to the St. Mary's capital campaign, Mary Lou and I prayed for God's guidance," he said. "When we decided, our decision became a three-way pact between SMHS, us, and God. We were committed to complete our giving because our giving is not about us, but about the unwavering generosity God has bestowed on us. With His help, together we unwaveringly bestow a portion of our good fortune onto SMHS. This is the essence of commitment and giving, and we have accomplished our goal."

Garcia said the key to moving St. Mary's forward is for its leaders to learn from past mistakes and improve on future efforts.

"St. Mary's is a young school when you consider that

it was just 1987 when it became independent of the diocese,” Garcia said. “That endeavor was undertaken with no financing and no endowment. As a young school, we will make mistakes but the key is to keep learning and to keep asking for those who love St. Mary’s to give back in a variety of ways.”

As St. Mary’s leaders look to the future, they will continue to seek help in providing the only Catholic high school college preparatory education in southern Colorado.

A Pirate Legacy of Giving

Ten Ernsters have graduated from St. Mary's since the early 1970s

When Al and Jody Ernster moved to Colorado Springs in 1962, it was a given that their five children would attend Catholic schools. Both Al and Jody had attended Catholic elementary schools in South Dakota, and chose Divine Redeemer for their children's elementary education with their oldest, Joel, starting there in third grade after the move.

Jody was a little preplexed, however, when Al began taking Joel to St. Mary's basketball games when Joel was only in the fourth or fifth grade. Al said to him it seemed like a natural thing to do—they knew many St. Mary's families and his son enjoyed sports. That was the beginning of the Ernster family's relationship with the high school.

"We felt that Catholic education was very important and we were and are dedicated to supporting it in every way we can," Al said. "For a town this size to have only one Catholic high school is a shame, and I'm going to do what I can to keep it going. That's just part of who I am."

Over the years, Al and Jody have seen many St.

Mary's alumni go on to become successful and influential people in their communities. Both feel that St. Mary's, as well as the families of these alums, are responsible for that success.

"People send their kids to St. Mary's because they want a better education, not because they can afford it," Jody said. "And St. Mary's encourages students to try their best at everything."

All five Ernster children graduated from St. Mary's, Joel being the first in 1972 and Molly being the last in 1983.

"I felt honored to go to a private Catholic high school," said Dr. Joel Ernster. "It was a privilege to attend St. Mary's. I always thought, 'Wow, this is better than the education the average kid gets.'"

The graduation of the five Ernster kids did not stop Al and Jody's involvement with the school. Al was a member of the Catholic Committee for Secondary Education, which kept St. Mary's High School open in 1987. That led to Al serving his second stint on the school's board of directors.

More than a decade after that tumultuous time for

the school, Joel and Greg's children began attending St. Mary's. While Catholic education was important to Joel, he said his wife, Jan, was adamant that their children—Nick '03, Mark '06 and Johnny '09—attend St. Mary's even though she herself did not attend a Catholic high school.

"Catholicism is a big part of our family identity," Dr. Ernster said. "By the time my kids attended St. Mary's, the school was past those challenging times of the '80s, and the academics were back to being some of the best in the city."

Joel also followed in his father's footsteps and served on the St. Mary's Board of Directors.

Al said that their son Greg '77, a chemical and petroleum engineer, moved back to Colorado Springs from overseas so his kids—Lauren '06 and Paul '08—could attend St. Mary's High School.

Although there are not currently any members of the Ernster family attending St. Mary's, the family continues to support the school with their time, talent, and treasure.

"St. Mary's has a unique perspective on education. It's great that Catholic families have the option of a Catholic high school, and we want to foster that in the competitive environment for high schools that we have in Colorado Springs and help St. Mary's stay viable," Dr. Ernster said.

ing to St. Mary's stems from his favorite movie, *It's a Wonderful Life*. Think about what life would be like without a Catholic education? Michael said that while the world wouldn't end, it would be a much bleaker place, void of the talents and virtues that a Catholic education at St. Mary's provides.

"What would it be like if St. Mary's didn't exist? It's a reality that I hope never happens, which is one reason I give to the school," he said. "St. Mary's helped create the person I am today. A large part of all the various physical, intellectual, social, emotional, and spiritual aspects of my being were formed during my four years at that Catholic school on East Yampa and that is something that I cannot come close to repaying. St. Mary's is one of the great gifts of my life."

While the Colorado Springs community has many good educational options, Greg Garcia agrees that St. Mary's offers something that none of the other schools can.

"St. Mary's is different, in that the education we

provide is a God-throughout type of education," he said. "God is at the center of the entire day through prayer and teaching. It's very important that Catholic schools are there to help mature our young people into young adults."

Cloud family supports St. Mary's after 90-plus years of association

Pat Cloud's family's association with St. Mary's began almost a century ago. Her father, Gerald Wagner, graduated from St. Mary's High School in 1929. Pat attended grade school at St. Mary's before switching to public schools for middle school and high school. After a one generation hiatus, the Clouds were back at St. Mary's when Pat's grandchildren began attending a decade ago.

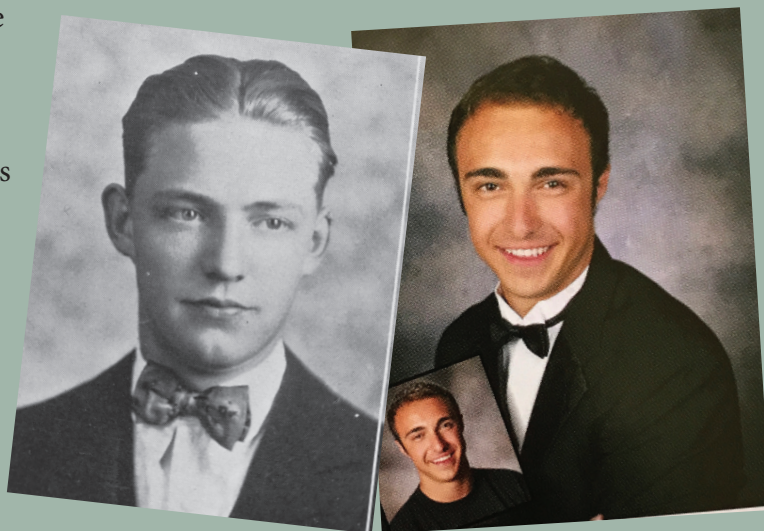
Over the years, Pat and her husband, Don, have generously supported St. Mary's High School in a variety of ways. Although the couple resides in Colorado Springs for only six months of the year, Don has served on the school's Board of Directors and continues to serve on the financial committee. Those experiences provided him with a deep understanding of the struggles faced by the only Catholic high school in southern Colorado.

In an effort to help, the Clouds have supported the We Believe campaign and fund an endowment through the diocese called the Cloud Family Fund. Both of these giving opportunities provide needed assistance for St. Mary's and its families.

The Cloud Family Fund is a personal way for the

family to support the school. The fund provides money that helps make a St. Mary's education available to families that may otherwise not be able to afford tuition.

"We decided to fund an endowment because we really liked the idea of helping with tuition so each year there are funds available to kids who could otherwise not afford a St. Mary's education," Don said.

Funds of the St. Mary's Catholic Education Foundation

The 1885 Fund

Established at the 125th Anniversary Gala in 2010, the 1885 Fund honors those whose leadership, commitment and dedication have ensured the school's continued success for its first 125 years and beyond. Honorees of the 1885 Fund include the Sisters of Loretto who founded the school in 1885; Monsignors Raber, Kipp, Kelly, and Hoffman, who guided the school as pastors, superintendents and principals; lay leaders such as [Leo Smentowski '54](#), Tom Kelly and Andy Middlemist and, of course, the hundreds of faculty, staff and religious, including Fr. Rawley Myers, who served the school unselfishly over the decades. The fund provides ongoing general operating support of St. Mary's High School.

The Ertel Family Endowed Scholarship

On an ordinary Friday afternoon in the spring of 2002, [Patrick Ertel '68](#) walked into SMHS and made an extraordinary gift. "I want the school to have this for scholarships for those in need," he said as he handed over an envelope. "These are some investments I inherited from my family. I managed them for some time, but have lost interest in them and have decided that they would be best used for this purpose."

Upon graduating, Ertel entered the seminary, but ultimately discerned that he did not have a calling to the priesthood. His love of the Church and of SMHS, however, continued to grow as he spent the next 35 years in various forms of service to others, first in the Peace Corps and then as a community volunteer. Grateful for the education that he received at SMHS, Ertel decided to create an endowed fund in his family's name. The Ertel Family Endowed Scholarship Fund provides a lasting revenue for financial aid. Ertel hopes to add to the fund in the years ahead.

The Ernest J. Golobic Endowed Scholarship

Ernest J. Golobic moved to Colorado Springs more than 20 years ago upon retiring from the USPS in Chicago. Though he and his wife, Catherine, had no formal

connection to SMHS, they valued Catholic education and began to support the school with yearly gifts to the Annual Fund.

When Mr. Golobic's sister-in-law, Margaret A. Rick, passed away she left him a modest inheritance. To honor his sister-in-law for her generosity and his wife's commitment to Catholic education, Mr. Golobic chose to create the Margaret A. Rick Endowed Memorial Scholarship Fund to support the school's financial aid program. This permanent fund provides the school with revenue to help ensure that SMHS will be available to those in need.

Shortly before his death in 2004, Mr. Golobic contributed some of his own assets to the scholarship fund and, with his daughter's encouragement, changed the name of the fund to The Ernest J. Golobic Family Endowed Scholarship Fund.

The Ernster-Blichmann Family Endowed Scholarship

[Greg Ernster '77](#) and his wife, Suzanne Blichmann Ernster, parents of [Lauren '06](#) and [Paul '08](#), established the Ernster-Blichmann Family Endowed Scholarship to provide need-based tuition assistance to students, particularly those interested in math, the sciences, sports, and/or debate. When possible, the gifts follow the receiving students for their entire time at SMHS so long as their need is proven to the Foundation each year.

The Tom Kelly Scholarship Fund

The St. Mary's Catholic Education Foundation has established the Tom Kelly Scholarship Fund in memory of Tom Kelly, who faithfully served the St. Mary's High School community as a member of the school board, foundation board, and in advisory capacity for more than 25 years. The fund benefits scholarship and financial aid programs of St. Mary's High School."

The Clergy Fund

The St. Mary's Catholic Education Foundation established the Clergy Fund to assist with the funding of the clergy office

at St. Mary's High School, including the salary of a school chaplain and supplies needed to carry out the mission of the office.

Anna Stevens Scholarship Fund

A local community volunteer and philanthropist, Anna Stevens desired to leave a lasting legacy through her estate. As part of her estate plan, she established the Anna Stevens Scholarship Fund to provide need-based tuition assistance to St. Mary's High School students.

The Good Sisters Fund

Named in honor of Srs. Valerie and Ann Monica Pierce, the Good Sisters Fund supplements funding of the school's curriculum and teacher development. Each semester, the department heads submit grant requests to the principal for funding of curriculum or programs that would not otherwise be available. The principal prioritizes the requests for the Foundation board which, pursuant to the Fund, awards \$1,500 per semester in grants.

In creating the Fund, Sr. Valerie hoped that it grow through additional gifts from SMHS families, friends, and alumni.

The Tafolla Family Fund

Patrice and Jerry Tafolla established the Tafolla Family Fund endowment in gratitude for all SMHS has provided their family, including an excellent education for their daughter, [Sarah '13](#), and son, [Michael '15](#). Their association with the school is a lifelong relationship rooted in faith, community, and a sense of belonging.

The Tafolla Family Fund is a legacy gift, providing permanent funding for debt relief and tuition assistance. At the end of each fiscal year, 5 percent of the balance of the fund is available to the school for the following school year.

The Tafollas intend to be lifelong supporters of SMHS, through the Annual Fund and events like the Golf Classic and the Gala, and by adding to the endowment fund. They encourage other families to consider a gift that will provide for the financial future of the school.
