

## NOTICE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE LAKE HOLCOMBE SCHOOL DISTRICT

State Statute 118.30 (1)(g)(a)(1) By August 1, 1998, each school board shall adopt pupil academic standards in mathematics, science, reading and writing, geography, and history. The school board may adopt the pupil academic standards issued by the governor as executive order no. 326, dated January 13, 1998. The Board of Education has approved the following standards prior to July 15, 2019 and reaffirmed their approval on July 17, 2023

Science Wisconsin State Standards and NextGen Science Standards  
Reading Wisconsin State Standards  
Writing Wisconsin State Standards  
Geography Wisconsin State Standards

State Statute 115.385(4) Annually, each public school, including a charter school, and each private school participating in a parental choice program under s. 118.60 or 119.23 shall provide a copy of the school's accountability report to the parent or guardian of each pupil enrolled in or attending the school.

Each school shall simultaneously provide to the parent or guardian of each pupil enrolled in the school a list of the educational options available to children who reside in the pupil's resident school district, including public schools, private schools participating in a parental choice program, charter schools, virtual schools, fulltime open enrollment, youth options, course options, and options for pupils enrolled in a home-based private educational program.

**Full-Time Open Enrollment:** 1. Any student that lives within the Lake Holcombe School District attendance boundaries has the option of attending any school district in the state of Wisconsin at no cost to the student. Forms do need to be filed with the Department of Public Instruction ([www.dpi.gov](http://www.dpi.gov)). Transportation is the responsibility of the student's family.

**Early College Credit Program:** High school students at public and private high schools in Wisconsin can earn early college credit through the Early College Credit Program (ECCP) A student selected for the program may be permitted to enroll in a UW System Institution, or an alternative private, non-profit

institution of high education (IHE) to take one or more courses for which the student may earn high school credit, post secondary credit, or both. Under ECCP, the costs of courses are shared among the IHE, the school district and private school, the state, and in some cases the student's family. Applications must be submitted by February 1 for Summer courses, March 1 for Fall courses, and October 1 for Spring courses.

**Start College Now:** "Start College Now" will allow high school students the opportunity to take college courses at Wisconsin Technical Colleges. Statute **38.12 (14)** lays out all the aspects of the program. Students looking to take courses in the fall semester must turn in the application by **March 1**. For spring semester courses the same application is used, however the due date is **October 1**.

**Options for Pupils Enrolled in home-based private educational program:** 1. On July 14, 2015, Governor Walker signed into law that all children in the state of Wisconsin that are eligible based upon the public school's requirements, may participate in all extracurricular activities. This may include participation in clubs, sports, or school sponsored activities. Please contact the Principal for more information regarding requirements.
