

Pamela Catt, Special **Education Teacher was** named CHS's teacher of the year. Janet Trease was named CHS's Support Staff of the Year.




Mrs. Bolles' students were busy this month cooking and making Mother's Day Cards.

Baseball Senior Night was held April 22nd before their game against Colcord.












