



## FHS PTSO Meeting Minutes

December 15, 2020

### Call to Order

A meeting of the FHS PTSO was held virtually via ZOOM on Tuesday, November 17, 2020. Co-President Kathy Wade called the meeting to order at 12:33 p.m. and adjourned at 1:14 p.m.

### Secretary's Report: Julie Vaught

The minutes from the November meeting were previously emailed to all the Executive Board. The minutes were unanimously approved without changes.

### Principal's Report: Dr. Jay Dostal:

Dr. Dostal reported that FHS decreased the rate of students with at least one F from 56% in September to 34% in December. Helping to work through issues with Seniors that need help graduating. Freshman and Sophomore kids are still struggling the most.

Blueprint for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester will be same as far as learning preferences. If a student needs to switch their learning preference, email Warren Collier. More students are transferring to home campus virtual. Teachers can hold synchronous zoom lessons with in-class and virtual students. Friday before the week, the teacher will give out a "week at a glance" outlining what is upcoming. Students will be learning how to practice time management with Google calendar and how to compose emails. Encourage students to check emails at least three times a day. Students will need to communicate with teachers on a daily basis about their learning and home environments and take responsibility for that. Tutoring is available through the Fayetteville Public Library through the ICard.

New attendance policies will be implemented beginning in January. No more than three graded assignments per week. Teachers will be expected to make sure all grades are updated in HAC every two weeks. Late assignment policy will be adjusted. Administration feels that its most important to assess student learning and not student behavior when it comes to late assignments.

186 students responded to a survey that Dr. Dostal sent out to several groups including Dawg Crew, Pup Crew, AVID, ESL, African American Male Initiative and several athletic groups.
