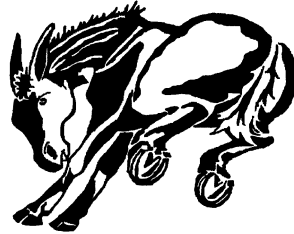

Vision Statement

Muleshoe ISD graduates positive, ethical, and productive citizens who are life-long learners.

2020-2021

1. All teachers will write and implement objective driven daily lesson plans with formative assessments including the 4 Common Sense Planning questions. Instruction and formative assessments are aligned and measured by weekly administrative team monitoring and 75% of students scoring at the meets level on common assessments.
2. 95% of all students, grades 2-12, will participate in a developmentally appropriate student needs assessment, geared toward identifying mental health and relationship concerns, by January 2021
Campus and district forums will be utilized to determine a program to address identified needs, by May 2021

A character and leadership development program will be implemented at the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year, at each MISD campus.
3. MISD will reduce the turnover rate for teachers by 15% (4 teaching positions) by continuing to grow and mentor beginning, as well as experienced teachers by the end of the 2020-2021 school year.
4. Muleshoe ISD will increase the percentage of students scoring at the MEETS level on STAAR from 33% to 40% on ALL tests.
5. Increase the percent of students who are “College Career Military Ready” Compliant without the use of College Prep Math and College Prep English Courses to 65% by 2024.
6. Muleshoe ISD will meet Federal requirements for the parent and family engagement for Title I and Title III.
