We have had an "awesome" back to school opening!! Thank you to ALL of the Eagle families!!!

We would like to apologize for any inconveniences that have occurred as we are trying to get our safety routines in place.



To all of our new families, here are a few protocols that will help your transition:

- **Students should NOT be dropped off before 7:15.** (There is **NO** supervision. If you leave your child without an admin or teacher telling you that they are on duty, that could lead to a supervision risk)
- **BREAKFAST** is available to all student free of charge. Try to get your child/children to school to give them enough time to eat. School starts at **7:45** which means student need to be in class by **7:45**. We close the breakfast doors at **7:40**.
- The school has 3 drop off areas:
 - **Bus/Daycare Lane**--Buses and Daycare Vans only.
 - **Car Rider Lane**--Parents must turn on Glenwood and follow Glenwood to East Shore Drive. (It is by a lake)
 - **PK drop off and pick up** is in the the back of the building. PK students have to be signed in and out.
- **Check-Outs:**
 - There will be **NO** checkouts after **2:15**. Dismissal is hectic and gets confusing when we have parents entering as we are relating transportation changes.

DRESS CODE

Uniforms are not required this school year but the district does have a dress and grooming policy.

- The student's dress should conform with a studious school atmosphere
- It is the principal's responsibility to ensure that dress is not extreme to the point of causing a disturbance or calls attention to the individual.
- Students are prohibited from wearing items that are obscene, lewd, demeaning or intimidating
- Students with extremely form fitting leggings and short crop tops that show their belly will be asked to change
- For safety reasons, we prefer you send your child to school tennis shoes. **Bubble slides** and **Crocs** cause more accidents in the hallways and playground. We strongly discourage these type of house shoes.

Visitors and Volunteers

Visitors must report to the office and scan their driver's licence to receive a visitors pass.



Parents who want to visit the classroom or any area where there are children present must have their digital volunteer ID card.

In addition to having a volunteer ID card, prior arrangements must have been made with the classroom teacher or administration

Parents may eat lunch without the volunteer ID card but must have a driver's licence or state issued ID to enter the building.

Anyone who wishes to volunteer at the school must complete a volunteer application prior to any assignment.

This includes a background check conducted online at no cost.
