1 COMMUNICATION

- Driven Virtual Academy Middle and High School will use various communication strategies to provide information to parents and to increase parental involvement in supporting classroom instruction.

- Home Access Center (HAC) gives parents the ability to access their student's final grades using a provided username and password (TBD, HAC Facilitator).
- Schoology is utilized by all classroom teachers for students and parents to access assignments, grades, teacher contact information, and announcements. (Parents have access using a parent code.)
- Interim reports and report cards are provided to parents every nine-week grading period with information regarding their student's academic progress (Ms. Story counselor).
- Thrillshare (a phone call) system is utilized to inform parents of upcoming events.

#4 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT/ TRAINING

DVA will provide two seminars that provide parents with information on how to become involved in school decision-making and how a parent can assist in their child's education.
