ASVAB: OCTOBER 25

All Juniors and many Seniors will be taking the ASVAB at Sylvan Hills on October 25th. The ASVAB is a timed, multi-aptitude test, which is given at more than 14,000 schools and Military Entrance Processing Stations (MEPS) nationwide. It is developed and maintained by the Defense Department (DoD). The ASVAB helps the DoD not just determine whether students are a good fit to join the service, but also which service branch each might be best for and even what military jobs they can hold after finishing basic training or boot camp.

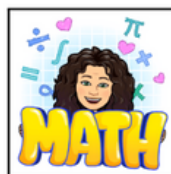

VOICE OF DEMOCRACY

Each year, the Voice of Democracy scholarship is open to student sin grades 9-12 by the October 31st deadline who are enrolled in a public, private, or parochial high school or home study program in the United States, its territories, and possessions; or dependents of US military or civilian personnel in overseas schools. WorkKeys assessments measure skills that employers feel are essential to success in the workplace. Students, job seekers, and seasoned professionals can use WorkKeys to learn more about their strengths and weaknesses and gain a valid way to demonstrate their abilities to employers.



- With NCRC credentials, students can show they have the skills to:
- Perform basic mathematical operations relevant to the workplace
- Read and understand documents commonly found in the workplace
- Find information presented in common workplace graphics
- Set up and solve complex, work-related mathematical problems
- Determine the relevance of written information to work-related tasks
- Apply information derived from graphics to work-related problems
