ACT ASPIRE

What is ASPIRE testing?

Many students (and even parents) can feel overwhelmed or worn out by standardized testing. At SHHS we believe that no number defines a student, and we are always committed to helping students become lifelong learners.

So **why** do we ASPIRE test?

End of year testing is a great tool to determine what students do and do not know, help them prepare for the ACT and college, and plan for the next school year.

As we prepare to take the ACT Aspire April 25 - May 3, discuss with your students their goals and achievements. Encourage them to get a good night's sleep. Make sure chromebooks are charged. Students with great success at this level will have even more success down the road.

Testing will begin at 8:35 each morning. Testing rosters are posted outside of classrooms.

Students who score *ready* or *exceeding* have a variety of incentives available.
