

#### #1COMMUNICATION

Sylvan Hills High School will use various communication strategies to provide information to parents and to increase parental involvement in supporting classroom instruction.

- Interim reports and report cards are provided to parents every nine weeks grading period with information regarding their student's academic progress (Carolyn Lipsmeyer, Lessie Kirchner, Shandre West counselors).
- Alert-Now (a phone call) system is utilized to inform parents of upcoming events.
- School Status online email, phone, and text system to broadcast or communicate with parents
- BEARmedia Bulletin, an E-Newsletter sent out weekly by parent facilitator (Ciara Cole)

#### #4 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT/ TRAINING

#### SYLVAN HILLS HIGH SCHOOL ENCOURAGES PARENTS TO:

**Activate a Home Access Code (HAC)** which provides a link between home and school. Through HAC parents may view their child's interim and report card grades, attendance, and discipline record. **Check Schoology weekly with your students** - <u>pcssd.schoology.com</u> contains information about all of your child's classes, teachers, assignments, and grades. You can also use it to contact any teachers or administrators for assistance.

**Read the SHHS Procedures Manual with your studen**t – The school's Procedures Manual is available electronically at <a href="mailto:shhs.pcssd.org">shhs.pcssd.org</a>. Procedures Manual information is addressed in each classroom and in grade level meetings the first week of school. This includes the school's rules on tardies, discipline, dress code, etc.

**Use the school's website to stay informed** - The website at shhs.pcssd.org contains news, a school calendar of events, scholarship information, ACT dates, registration information and a quick access to HAC.

**Use social media to stay informed** - Sylvan Hills High School has a Facebook page and a Twitter account. Additionally, several clubs, organizations, and sports teams have social media accounts to keep parents informed.

**Complete a parent volunteer survey** – This survey, which is available at <a href="shhs.pcssd.org">shhs.pcssd.org</a> as well as in the Parent Center of SHHS, will make the parent involvement coordinator knowledgeable of parental interest areas in volunteerism as well as provide suggestions for improvement of programs, workshops, etc.
