## # 1 COMMUNICATION

Sylvan Hills Jr. High School will use various communication strategies to provide information to parents and to increase parental involvement in supporting classroom instruction.

- Interim reports and report cards are provided to parents every nine weeks grading period with information regarding their student's academic progress (Ms. Monica Williams counselor).
- Thrillshare (a phone call) system is utilized to inform parents of upcoming events.
- School Status online email, phone, and text system to broadcast or communicate with parents.
- Sylvan Hills High School Facebook page shares highlights of current events..

## #4 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT/ TRAINING

SHJHS will provide two seminars that provide parents with information on how to become involved in school decision-making and how a parent can assist in their child's education.

Activate a Home Access Code (HAC) which provides a link between home and school. Through HAC parents may view their child's grades, attendance, and discipline record. Also through HAC, parents and teachers can communicate via email. Ms. Pace, the guidance secretary, can help parents get set up with HAC access.

Read the SHJHS Procedures Manual with your student – The school's policy handbook is placed on the school website and discussed with students at the beginning of each year. It contains the school's rules on tardiness, discipline, dress code, etc. This manual is also available electronically at shjhs.pcssd.org under Student Information.

**Use the school's website to stay informed** – The website at shjhs.pcssd.org contains news, a school calendar of events, scholarship information, ACT dates, registration information and a quick access to HAC.

**Use Schoology with your students** – pcssd.schoology.com contains information about all of your child's classes, teachers, assignments, and grades. You can also use it to contact any teachers or administrators for assistance.

**Use social media to stay informed** – Sylvan Hills High School has a Facebook page and a Twitter account. Additionally, SHBEARSATHLETICS is the life of the athletes in photos.

**Complete a parent volunteer survey** – This survey, which is available on the homepage of ships.pcssd.org as well as on the counter of the main office of SHHS, will make the parent involvement coordinator knowledgeable of parental interest areas in volunteerism as well as provide suggestions for improvement of programs, workshops, etc.
