2017 Back to School Dance

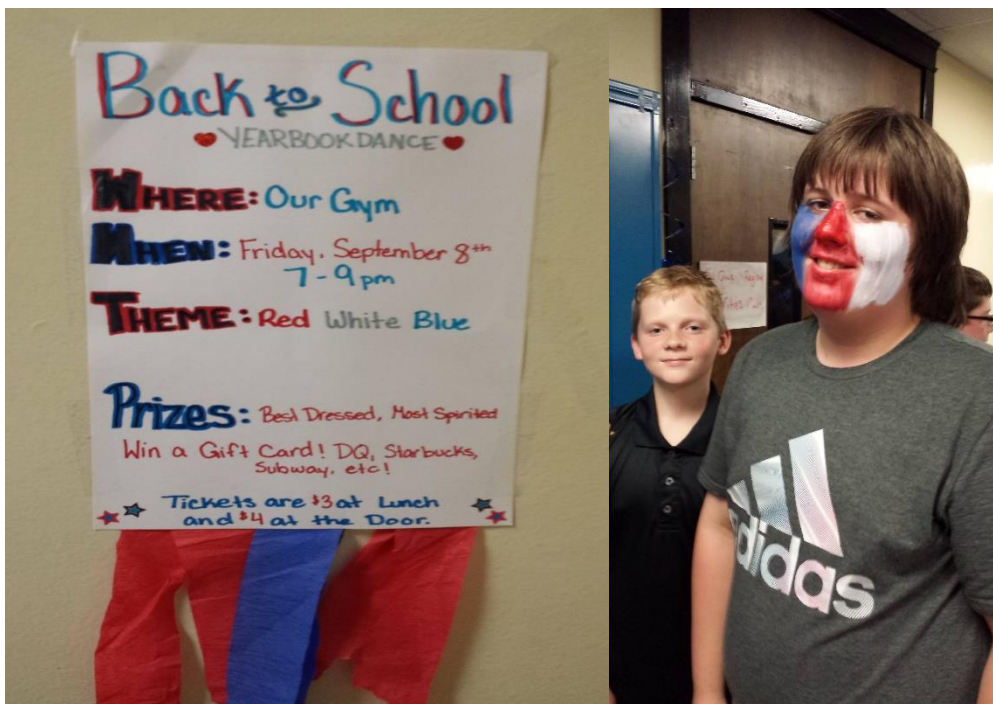
