Dear Tonawanda City School District Students, Staff and Families:

We have received notification of a confirmed case of COVID-19 of three individuals participating in the recent fully remote instructional program from Riverview Elementary School (1) and the MS/HS building (2). These three individuals have not been on our school campus since we returned to a hybrid model. For reasons of confidentiality of personal health records and protected information, we cannot legally provide the name or any other personally identifiable information regarding the individuals who tested positive.

Your receipt of this notice DOES NOT mean that you or your child have been exposed to or have come in close or proximate contact with the individuals who have tested positive. The people that tested positive for COVID-19 at Riverview and in the MS/HS building have not and will not be on campus or interacting with others in the school while we had previously been in a fully remote instructional program. The district wanted to share this information out of an abundance of caution and transparency within our school community.

Be assured, however, that the District is taking all appropriate steps in light of this information. We have contacted the Erie County Department of Health who will be conducting contact tracing. The County will contact all individuals who may have been in contact off campus and within our community with the individuals who have tested positive. Please remember that all individuals who are contacted are expected to comply with all directives and instructions issued by the Department of Health, including any requirement to self-quarantine for any designated period.

The District put in place infectious disease health and safety protocols to minimize the spread of the virus and any other illnesses. All students, parents, guardians, siblings, and staff should continue to monitor their health for symptoms of COVID-19 and follow the guidelines listed on the District website. Please remember, if you are ill or experiencing any of the symptoms of COVID-19, stay at home and contact your medical provider for assistance.
