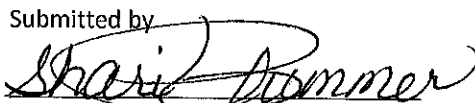
### **8.1 COVID19**

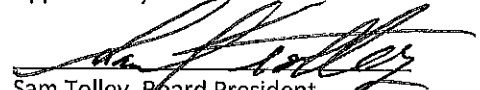
