Student Enrollment	All PCS students not requesting or requiring one of the other options	K-12 students may request this option by contacting their principal or the BOE. Student will still be enrolled in PCS. Student must meet enrollment guidelines and make application. Enrollment is required for at least one semester.	Students medically unable to attend (as required by physician). Student will be still be enrolled in PCS.	Parent/guardian must complete applicable paperwork through the BOE. Student will not be enrolled in PCS.	All students receiving instruction through in-person/blended model (if/when governor determines full remote is required) will transition to full remote. Students will be required to complete assignments and engage remotely five days a week. Teacher and students required to communicate regularly and utilize a process for monitoring, reviewing and/or gradient student engagement activities.

In-person instruction/assignments will be delivered in a traditional manner. Fifth day will be delivered either via computer or learning packets (if computer access is not available).
