CREW APPLICATIONS PROCESS

In order to be eligible to be a crew member, you must be an MCS student in grades 7-12. You must also complete the stage crew or tech crew application. Priority will frequently be given to applicants who have prior experience, but experience is not necessary to apply.

- Crew positions include: Stage crew, set construction, set design, sound and light technicians, special effects, media/projection, costumes, hair, and make-up artists.

Participation in the 2020 MCS production of "James and the Giant Peach" is a privilege, and as such, there are many conditions that must be followed. A production of this magnitude requires months of rigorous work from all members of the cast and crew, and any deficiencies reflect on all of the members. The success of the show depends on everyone being in their place and on time.

In order to be cast in the show, you MUST NOT have any conflicts with the rehearsals during Tech Week (March 23-29) or during the run of the show (March 30 - April 2). With that said, we do honor other conflicts that we are aware of prior to casting the show. Please list on the back of this letter any conflicts that you might have, including weekly commitments. This will help us in scheduling rehearsals so that we can improve productivity and minimize the amount of re-teaching that will need to take place.

A MANDATORY production meeting will be held at 7:00 PM on Monday, November 28th in the Student Life Center to distribute information packets that will guide the students and parents through the production process. ALL POTENTIAL CAST AND CREW MEMBERS will be required to attend the parent meeting along with at least one parent and/or guardian. The first rehearsal will take place on Monday, January 9th at 6:30 PM in the Student Life Center. For the majority of the rehearsal process, we will rehearse on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. During Tech week, we will add weekend rehearsals as well.

One other item of note: Our productions will never contain ACTUAL KISSING, so no students or parents will need to be uncomfortable about their child's actions on stage. Kissing that is written in the script will be implied in the action on stage, but will not involve actual contact.
