USD 109's policy states that schools are to be closed due to weather that is hazardous. Our primary notification of school closings will be made through our district mass notification system, PowerSchool. This system will automatically contact parents and students of the closing once school has been deemed closed. We will also notify the following stations regarding school closing.

Mass announcement TIPS:

\*\*\* The system delays after the announcement is answered. Please wait a few seconds before you hang up.  
\*\*\* Please keep your phone numbers updated through your child's school office or the district office.  
\*\*\*If you miss the announcement, check the website for additional posts.

Making the determination to close schools is a delicate process. If you have followed weather predicting in Kansas, it is obvious that no one has mastered the skill as of yet.

Our process for school closing includes transportation director, Craig Allen, beginning road condition assessments as early as 3AM. This sounds a bit early, but since our school district sprawls over hundreds of square miles this early time is necessary. The superintendent joins the assessment soon after and eventually is the one responsible to make the school closure decision. It is a goal to have this decision made by 6am with a Mass Alert announcement made by 6:30am. Conditions can vary through the county. So, no matter the district's decision, we understand if parents choose not to send their children to school because conditions are more extreme in their part of the county.
